### **PLAT REVIEW**

The council was presented a preliminary plat for the "North Street Addition" that was recently approved by the planning and zoning board. The plat under review is purposing 5 lots be constructed on the North side of North Street, where the old bowling alley used to be. Traer Development Corp. has been working with Helland Engineering on this preliminary plat but cannot move forward with planning until it's approved by the council. Approving the plat would allow TDC to move further with the planning, and potentially come back to the council with a finalized plat that would then need final approval. MOTION by Erhardt, seconded by Rund, to approve the preliminary plat for the North Street Addition. Motion approved unanimously with a roll call vote.
